

ROSA PRESIDENT IS TAKING PART AT THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CLIMATE CHANGE & DISASTER MANAGEMENT, 26-28 FEBRUARY 2015, INDIA

The President of the Romanian Space Agency (ROSA), Marius-loan Piso, is participating at the International Conference on Climate Change & Disaster Management, which is taking place in Kovalam, Thiruvananthapuram, India, from 26 to 28 February 2015. The event brings together scientists and policy makers from all over the globe and synthesizes opinions in preparation of an IAA Heads of Space Agencies Summit on September 14-15, 2015 in Mexico.

During the conference, technical and policy matters related to Climate Change will be discussed, such as climate change variables, current status and projections for future, role of private sector and also issues related to Disaster Management: communication networks through international cooperation, research efforts and knowledge integration for developing early warning systems/models, Earth observation based disaster alert methods and satellite based technologies for disaster management.

The President of the Romanian Space Agency will participate in the round table during the "Climate Change: Modelling & reanalysis" session, which took place on 26 February and brought and brought face to face leaders of organisations and departments.

The Conference is jointly organised by the International Academy of Astronautics (IAA), the International Institute of Space Law(IISL), Department of Earth Sciences (MoES) Govt of India and the Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment(KSCSTE).
