**1. Attendance**

**2. Status Report**

The co-chairs and rapporteur attended the IAA Commission V, and Dr. Kai-Uwe Schrogl reported to the chairmen (Dr. John Logsdon and Mr. Gerard Brachet) and briefed them on the progress of the study group.

From the last draft dated August 15, the co-chairs and rapporteur will add the inputs from the Wednesday October 1<sup>st</sup> IAA and IISL sessions.

**3. Procedure**

When we will have an updated report, there will be a second circulation beginning 2004 among the Group 1. We will ask for feedback by July 2004. After incorporated the additional input, another circulation this time among the larger group (Group 2) will be done before IAC Vancouver next year.

After IAC, the official IAA Review process will be launched and following this, the study will be published in the course of 2005. We suggest having a scientific-legal roundtable on space traffic management at IAC 2005 in Japan.

4. **Bremen 2003**

There has been a good harmonization of the IAA and IISL sessions. There were no competing presentations with 2 sessions (3 hours each) the same day: the technical session (IAA) in the morning, and the legal session (IISL) in the afternoon. We received some pertinent and good comments that will enrich the current draft.
