# 7) Go around the room

- P. Jukola presented her brief ideas how to capture the memoirs and knowledge of space pioneers either through video or oral interviews. After a long discussion how this can be accomplished, Mrs. Jukola was asked to submit a proposal to the committee with a detailed description, actions to be undertaking. Lessons learned from other efforts, such as JSC Oral History Project, could be considered.
- Skoog: Skoog: reports that session chairs and rapporteurs have to ensure a proper review of papers to recommend 1-3 papers per session for publication in Acta Astronautica (in addition to the proceedings
- SETI colleagues have approached us to inquire if we would be interested in having papers on the History of SETI in our symposium. The overall response was positive. We are starting this new cooperation by splitting the Canadian session in two, in which the second part will be dedicated to the SETI topic.
